College Connect does not duplicate resources that are already in place at the college. We partner with student services to provide individualized support for students to help them achieve academic success.

We believe in life beyond the aide, meaning we provide services outside of the academic classroom that requires students to participate in all aspects of the program. Students will learn to initiate, plan and advocate for themselves while creating meaningful friendships and building a community of peers.
