WHAT DREW YOU TO COLLEGE CONNECT ORIGINALLY?
















[College Connect August Snapshot]

THE COOKING CORNER

Elote (Mexican Street Corn)

<u>Ingredients</u>

- 6 to 8 medium ears sweet corn, husks removed
- 1/2 cup Mexican crema, or sour
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
- 1/2 cup chopped cilantro
- 1 clove garlic, minced
- 1/4 teaspoon ground chipotle pepper
- 2 teaspoons finely grated lime zest
- 2 tablespoons lime juice, from 1 lime
- 1/2 cup cotija cheese, crumbled
- · Lime wedges, to serve



Directions

- 1. Grill the corn
- 2. Prepare your sauce and sprinklings. While the corn is cooking, mix together mayonnaise, lime juice, chili powder, optional cayenne and salt. In another bowl, mix together grated Cotija cheese and cilantro.
- 3. Brush the corn with the mayo blend.
- 4. Sprinkle the Cotija and cilantro mixture all over.
- 5. Finish it off with a sprinkle of chili powder.
- 6. Enjoy!
